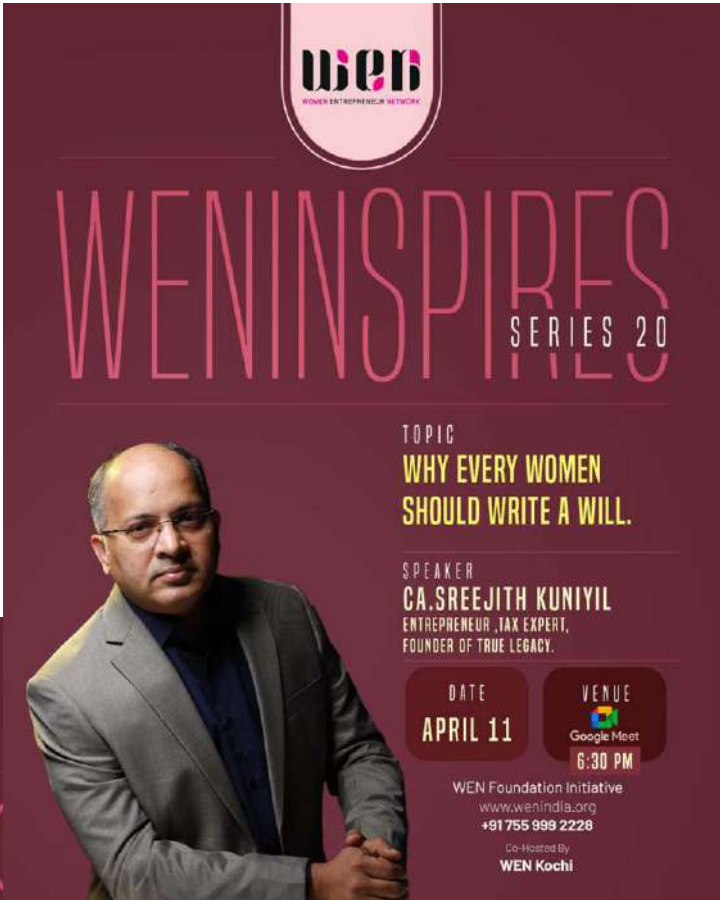
Together, these sessions reinforced our commitment to providing WENnites with the tools not only to grow their businesses but also to secure their futures.

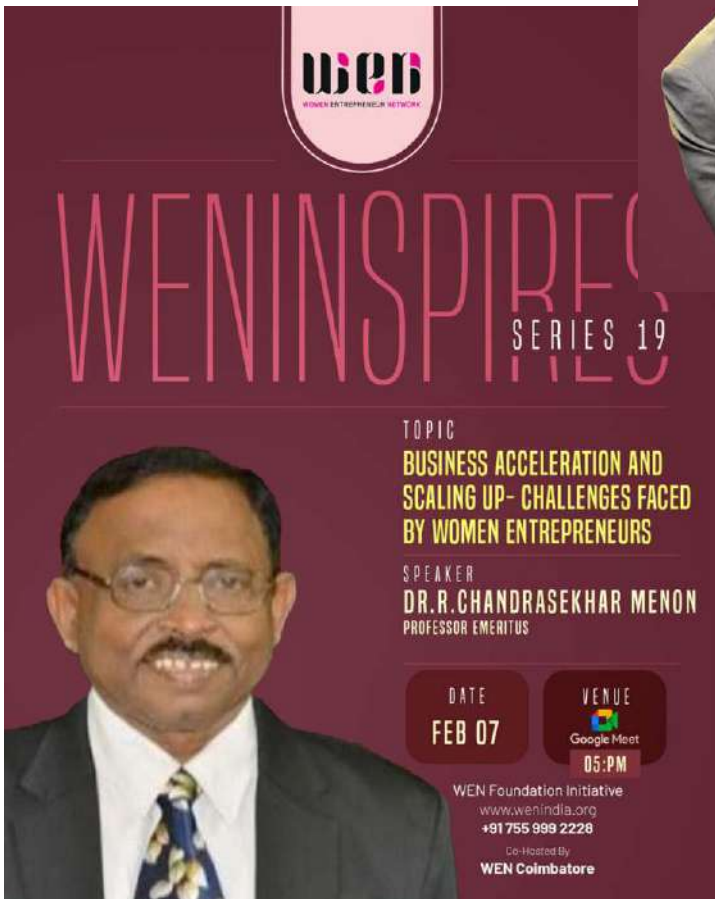

The February Prelude: Inner Well-being & Outer Confidence

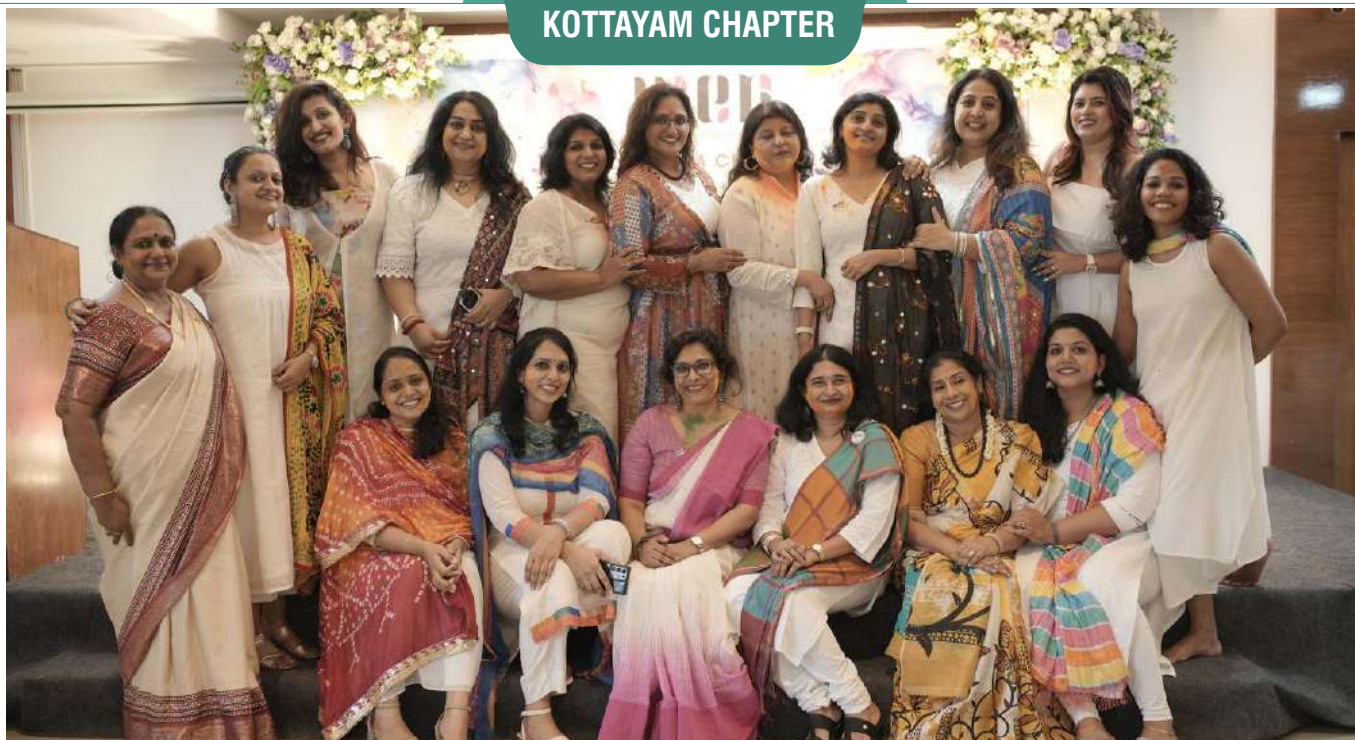

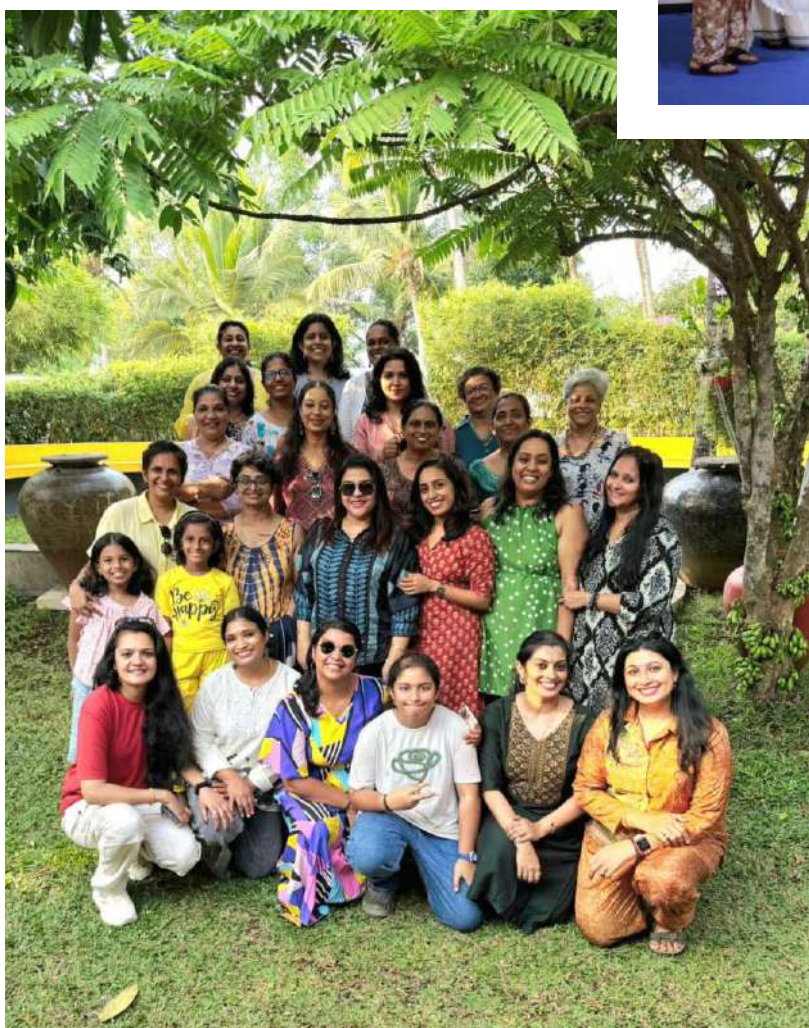

Beyond the Bouquet: The Soul of a Kochi Wedding

There is something about Kochi that makes a wedding feel a little more intimate, a little more rooted, and a little more real. In the middle of this setting, there is an art to listening and observing before a single detail is shaped.
