A huge congratulations to our Coimbatore chapter for a successful launch! We're excited to see the impact this new chapter will have in the region.


Our boot camps and training sessions have equipped members with valuable skills, while partnerships with like-minded organizations have opened doors to new opportunities.





Framing the Smile with Facial Aesthetics

1. Lip Volume & Shape

The lips should

Reveal the right amount of upper and lower teeth at rest and while talking

Have a well-defined Cupid's bow and border that is in harmony with the cheek and chin contours

Lip filler can add structure and not just volume , for a natural expression.

2. Balancing Facial Lines

Smile folds like nasolabial creases and marionette lines deepen over time.

Biostimulatory fillers can restore facial support without overfilling.

Soft tissue lift can enhance the smile and youthfulness.

Toxoids Small doses of Botox (one of the brands) can:

- -Correct a crooked or lopsided smile
- —Reduce a "gummy smile" by relaxing the levator labii superioris muscle(the muscle that raises your lips when you smile)
- -Fine-tune expressions without freezing your face

4. Midface Volume for Cheek Support

The midface anchors your smile. If it's sunken, even perfect teeth can look tired.

Restoring cheek volume lifts the oral commissure (corners of the mouth)

Prevents smile sagging, especially with age
